

Improving Your TCC Home WIFI

Access Point Install Instructions



Traditional routers can have limited range



Adding an Access Point[s] can add more range through your home & property

- 1.** Make sure the switch on the back of the AP is set to RP mode
- 2.** Plug the power in and turn the AP on. This process works best if you can boot the AP the first time right beside the Zyxel Router before you deploy it to its new home in another area of your house.
- 3.** Once the AP is booted, the LED light with the dot surrounded by a circle or arrows will flash on and off.
- 4.** Now, press and hold the WPS button [Key Button] on the router until the WIFI LEDs flash orange
- 5.** The AP will auto configure. Once all the LEDs come on and the top icon with the key in the circle is solid, you can unplug the device and move it to where it needs to go.
- 6.** If the AP is in a good spot the signal levels on the AP will be **GREEN**.
AMBER means you need to move the AP farther from the router.
RED means it needs to be closer to the router.
RED BLINKING means there is no connection to the router.
